# MONOPRINTING FROM THE NATURAL WORLD - SERAPHINA MARTIN

### THURS 13 JAN 10AM - 4PM \$180

**1 DAY WORKSHOP** 

Monoprinting is a direct printmaking process with unexpected and exciting results. We will have fun by experimenting with organic and found objects from nature. Participants will learn how to create impressive prints using elements such as leaves, feathers and textured papers as well as enjoy embossing into paper. In this one day workshop, there will be a focus on colour and texture working with a variety of tools and natural materials in ways that reflect their organic nature. Participants will create a stunning portfolio of unique prints in a creative environment.

**2 DAY WORKSHOP** 

Produce a stunning portfolio of up to 12 colourful prints using aluminium plates etched in copper sulphate. This non-toxic process of aluminium etching involves intaglio techniques such as hard ground / soft ground using textures from found objects. Tonal passages similar to the aquatint technique are created without rosin dust, making this a friendly approach to fine art printmaking. Emphasis on colour will involve using viscosity in the inks and stencils with up to 6 colours in one passage through the etching press, resulting in exciting variations to enhance your images.
